

HUNTON PARISH COUNCIL
MINUTES OF THE EXTRAORDINARY COUNCIL MEETING
HELD ON MONDAY 26TH MARCH 2012
AT HUNTON VILLAGE HALL

IN ATTENDANCE: One parishioner was in attendance.

1. APOLOGIES

There were no apologies.

2. COUNCILLOR DECLARATIONS

There were no councillor declarations.

3. PLOT 5, LAND AT LUGHORSE LANE APPEAL EXPENSES

Members discussed a request from residents to reimburse £379.36 incurred in the production of the document objecting to planning application 10/1542 – Plot 5, Land at Lughorse Lane. The costs represent approximately 10% of the overall expenditure incurred by residents on the appeal process. Members **Agreed** that the residents should not be reimbursed by the Parish Council as the request was made retrospectively after the costs were incurred. As Parish Council funds are used for the benefit of all Hunton parishioners, the Parish Council should have been approached formally at a meeting prior to the costs actually being incurred.

4. PURCHASE OF PLOTS OF LAND AT THE CHANCES, LUGHORSE LANE

Members discussed a request from residents to support the purchase of plots of land at The Chances, Lughorse Lane. Members **Agreed** to support the proposal in principle and would consider pursuing it further if it proved practical, but consideration would need to be given to a number of factors, including how the land would be used.
