4. MINUTES OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 3RD JULY 2023

6. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

The following planning applications were considered, and recommendations made:

6.1 Land Adjacent To Scotts House, West Street - 23/503009/FULL

Erection of 18 no. ground mounted solar PV panels on land adjacent to Scotts House.

Parish Council recommendation: No objection.

6.2 Land Off Water Lane - 23/502944/FULL

Creation of a 150m2 nature conservation pond for Great Crested Newts.

Parish Council recommendation: No objection.

6.3 Rose Cottage, Bishops Lane - 23/503045/FULL

Creation of a 150m2 nature conservation pond for Great Crested Newts.

Parish Council recommendation: No objection.

6.4 Stonewall, East Street - 23/503325/SUB

Submission of details pursuant to condition 3 (Historic Environment Record) of application 22/505899/LBC.

Parish Council recommendation: None as Maidstone Borough Council approved the submission prior to the meeting.

7. REPORTED PLANNING DECISIONS

No planning decisions have been made by Maidstone Borough Council since the last Full Council meeting.

8. TREE SURGERY

A quote of £450 plus VAT has been obtained from Hood's Tree Services Ltd to raise the crowns of seven Oak trees and three Maple trees on the recreation ground, following a recommendation from the King George V Playing Field Committee. Members **Agreed** that the quote should be accepted. Members **Authorised** expenditure of up to £600 for any additional tree surgery required, such as raising the crown of the Lime tree near the Village Hall entrance.
